Rule 1002 Notice

2012 Federal Legal Holidays^{1/}

PCAOB Rule 1002 governs the computation of periods of time prescribed in or allowed by the Board's rules or orders. Under Rule 1002, federal legal holidays affect the computation of these time periods in certain circumstances. The Note to Rule 1002 provides that the Secretary will maintain a list of federal legal holidays. For 2012, those holidays are:

January 2	New Year's Day
January 16	Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr.
February 20	Washington's Birthday
May 28	Memorial Day
July 4	Independence Day
September 3	Labor Day
October 8	Columbus Day
November 12	Veterans Day
November 22	Thanksgiving Day
December 25	Christmas Day
